

Emerald Chocozebra Siam Tulip

Curcuma x 'Emerald Chocozebra'



Inflorescence is a spike of dramatic apple green bracts with chocolate-bronze stripes at the base of the bracts and a dash of chocolate in the throat. Lavender flowers can be found deep within the bracts. The bract spike is long-lasting and makes a wonderful cut flower. Curcumas are day-length sensitive, and will go dormant in November. They will return in May as soon as the temps heat up for another fabulous display. 18"-24" tall, slowly multiplies into a beautiful clump.
